CALL FOR ABSTRACTS & FULL LENGTH PAPERS

Abstract & Full-Length Paper Submission

Authors are requested to submit an **abstract of 250–300 words** in English, including 4–5 relevant keywords, prepared in Times New Roman (12 pt) and submitted **only in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)** format. The **presenting author's name should be underlined**. Submissions in PDF, PowerPoint (PPT), or any other format will not be accepted.

Authors of accepted abstracts are invited to submit a **full-length paper of 3,000–4,000 words** in **English**, prepared in Times New Roman (12 pt) and submitted **only in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)** format. PDF submissions will not be accepted.

Both abstracts and full-length papers must be prepared in accordance with the official **Author Guidelines** and **Paper Template** available on the official Summit website. Authors may submit their abstracts and full-length papers either through the **online submission form** available on the conference website or via email at: **conference.esda@gmail.com**.

While submitting the abstract, authors are requested to clearly indicate:

Paper Presentations

The 7th World Environment Summit 2026 provides an international platform for researchers, academicians, scientists, industry professionals, and students to present their research before a global audience. Accepted papers may be presented in any of the following modes:

- **Oral Presentation** (Physical or Virtual)
- **Poster Presentation** (Physical or Virtual)

Oral Presentations

Each oral presentation will be allotted **7–10 minutes**, followed by **2–3 minutes** for discussion and questions. Presentations should be prepared in **Microsoft PowerPoint (PPT/PPTX)** or **PDF** format and should clearly present the objectives, methodology, results, conclusions, and key recommendations of the research.

Poster Presentations

Physical posters should be prepared in **portrait orientation (60 cm × 90 cm)** and include the title, author details, introduction, methodology, results, conclusions, and key references. Virtual posters should be submitted as a **single-page PDF or PowerPoint** file and may include a brief online presentation during the designated poster session.
